VIRGINIA ZOO

Educate the whole family on animals from all over the world. Walk amongst Australian Wallabies and their joeys, spot Africa's majestic rhinos, admire the new World of Reptiles exhibit and play with goats at the Zoo Farm. The Virginia Zoo is home to over 700 critters which gives something for everyone in the family to see!



BATTLESHIP WISCONSIN AND NAUTICUS

Spend the day exploring Nauticus, a maritime museum showcasing global trade and the world's largest Navy. On the Nauticus Campus resides the Battleship Wisconsin, one of the last and largest battleships built by the United States. Explore the decks and depths of the ship and don't forget to take a family photo!



CHRYSLER MUSEUM OF ART AND PERRY GLASS STUDIO

The Chrysler Museum of Art is a museum of 30,000 objects spanning over 5,000 years. They have a Wonder Studio which is an interactive kidfriendly space, and a glass studio across the street, Perry Glass Studio, where your family can watch free glass-making demonstrations.



NORFOLK BOTANICAL GARDEN

Norfolk Botanical Garden is nationally recognized for its deep-rooted history and celebrated for its blooms in every season. The 175-acre garden is home to 52 distinctive themed gardens and 95 species of birds. Check out the World of Wonders, a Children's Adventure Garden, with 3-acres where kids explore the connections between plants, culture and the environment.
